

# Operational Challenges Experienced by Legal Departments

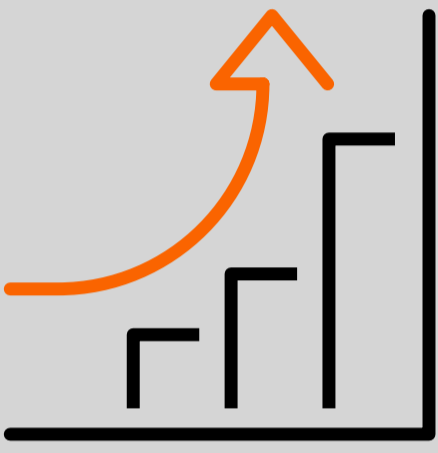
## 1. Burden of document creation

**49%** want other depts to be self sufficient in handling standard contracts<sup>1</sup>. Legal departments prefer to spend their time focusing on high-value legal work such as advising.



## 2. Causing expensive errors

**52%** depts seek to create efficient in-house legal request management processes<sup>1</sup>. This will enable them to minimise cost to clients and demonstrate value.



## 3. Lack of visibility into document versions

**59%** find keeping up with changing risk and compliance landscape tough<sup>1</sup>. Legal counsels believe workflow and operations improvement can enable better coordination and end-to-end process management.



## Solution:

**71%** legal departments place highest emphasis on using technology to simplify workload<sup>1</sup>

26% of adopters feel document automation had the greatest impact on ability to succeed<sup>1</sup>
